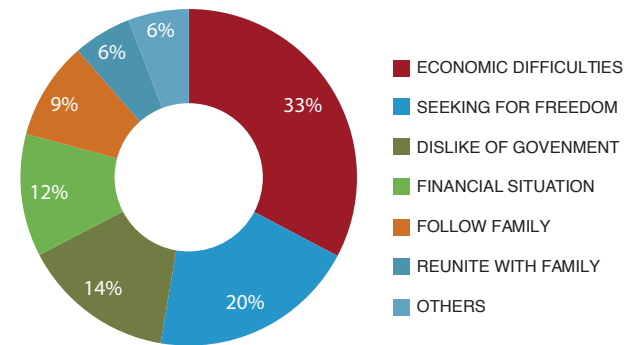


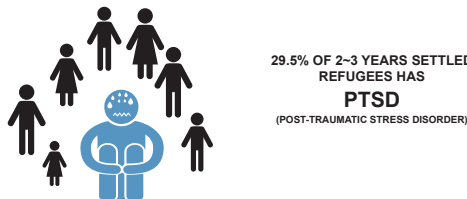

## PROJECT STATEMENT

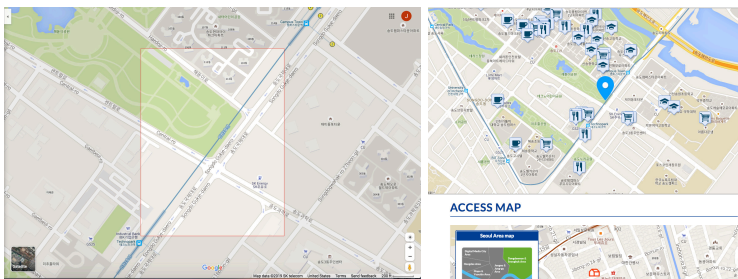
